OLD BUSINESS

Proposal 2/26/01 made by the treasury last month to create a work group to create financial procedures to issue funds for trusted servants and area needs.

NEW BUSINESS

Proposal 3/26/01 To establish a \$100 line item to support groups. Created by Suz Jason: For new groups, struggling groups, to support all the groups. So for anyone that wasn't here, there was a long conversation about it. They want to put a line item in the budget.

Steve E.: What exactly is the \$100 for?

Jason: Say a new meeting is starting and they need to have a key made and they want to buy a little bit of literature, we already have in our guidelines a starter kit but there are certain things that are not included. This is not to say that they are going to come in here and we are going to hand them \$100, we are going to see what they need and they are going to provide a receipt.

Steve E.: I just wanted to make sure the starter kit was still involved.

Jason: If a struggling group comes in and says we can't pay our rent we might lose our facility then the area might be able to help them pay their rent.

Jef: Example: If we have good attendance and a lot of newcomers coming but we can't pay our rent we need help this month, then that just puts \$100 aside.

Steve E.: So if a group is struggling and they can't pay their expenses, that is a problem.

Jessie Jane: I can give you an example, one point at W.I.S.H we had 10-20 newcomers and we were not getting anything in the basket but we had attendance of almost 30 people so situations like that, if we couldn't collect enough to make the rent we could come here and get the money and we can keep the group going and newcomers have a place to go even though they can't put a dollar in the basket.

Jonathan: Our group spoke about what happens when multiple groups come and also I would like to see if we can get it added that if a group does come ask for help that we announce that they need help. So more people can visit them and support them so we can make arrangements to try and go to that meeting.

Jason: I know what you are saying and we try to encourage that if your group is struggling then come here and say so first. We are not saying that we are going to

let a group come in here every month and ask for money for rent, if it happens more than one time then we are going to visit it and decide if it is responsible to keep paying the rent. Like Jessie said, if they have 30 people and 20 of them are newcomers that might be something different but ultimately it is the decision of the GSRs.

Tami: Sometimes I think we need to take a step back. I went to a work group and we were sitting at a table with people from Japan. We said we had meetings that we were closing because no one attended them. The lady from Japan gasped when she heard that and she said “We do not let meetings close. If we have to drive 200 miles to a meeting and we can make sure a meeting stays open for even having one person there then we support it.” I felt so humbled and embarrassed that they couldn’t believe we would let a meeting close.

TJ: Not to get away from the actual motion itself, but it literally is a motion to just go ahead and line item \$100 so in the event, everybody can argue about it afterwards but it’s just so we have \$100 for it. So we don’t have to go in our own pocket, we don’t have to scramble when a new group comes in or an emergency occurs. We just have a \$100 line item that is literally all the motion is. Just adding a \$100 line item to the budget.

Jason: So does everyone understand the proposal now? We are good as it is to send out to the groups? Everyone agreed so the proposal will be sent out to the groups.
